The above approval is subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

1. Adequate infrastructural and other instructional facilities in terms of building space (class rooms, laboratories, faculty rooms, etc.), machinery & equipment, furniture, fittings, library books etc. should be provided.
2. No new courses shall be started or on-going courses shall be discontinued by the institutions without the prior approval of the AICTE.
3. The intake in any year shall not be altered without the prior approval of the AICTE.
4. All infrastructural, instructional and other facilities shall be provided as per AICTE norms prescribed from time to time.
5. Teaching and other staff shall be selected according to procedure, qualifications, experience and pay scales as prescribed by AICTE from time to time, and that they shall be paid full salaries and allowances regularly and in time.
6. The institutions shall not charge any capitation fee or donation for admission or other higher charges from the students/guardians of the students in any form.
7. Admissions shall be made on merits and as per the norms & guidelines of the AICTE.
8. The State Government policies for admissions of SC/ST, other weaker sections of society etc. shall be followed by the Institutions.
9. The Institutions may be visited by an officer or a Committee of the AICTE or of its Regional Office from time to time to review the progress made by the Institutions in fulfilling conditions as laid down by the AICTE.
10. In the event of non-compliance of the guidelines, norms & standards prescribed by the AICTE, the AICTE shall be free to take measures for withdrawal of the approval without consideration of any related issues and that liabilities arising out of such withdrawal would be solely that of the Trust/Society and/or the Institutions.
